## SPRING 2017 GRANTS AWARDED

Destination Missoula/Missoula Tourism Business Improvement District grants have been awarded for the spring cycle

Funds were awarded to: the American Legion NW Regional Baseball Tournament, the Big Sky Gun Show, MCT, Inc. Tour Actor/Director Reunion, Montana State Chapter P.E.O.'s 2018 State Convention, Montana Wilderness Association's WildFest, and the University of Montana Cheer Squad's Griz Glam Jam.

"The Montana State Chapter of P.E.O. is excited to bring its annual convention to Missoula in June of 2018," said Kay Duffield, Past State President for the Montana State Chapter P.E.O. "The grant we have received will allow us to bring in speakers who have received educational assistance from us and to provide great entertainment at our banquet. We are hoping by partnering with the [Missoula] TBID our members, their guests, and the project recipients will look forward to coming back to Missoula and taking advantage of all that it has to offer."

Destination Missoula/Missoula TBID is excited to support such diverse events ranging from arts and culture, to meetings and sporting events. The Missoula TBID grant funds are generated from a \$2 per-room-night assessment collected by participating hotels. The purpose of the Missoula TBID grant fund is to provide funding for new and/or growing events, preferably in non-peak months (October-April) that will provide an economic benefit through increased hotel room nights and other spending within the Missoula community.
